>> RACHEL: Let's go!

SFX: Door closing



>> RACHEL: (Getting quieter.) Loofah have you ever seen Stark Trek?

SFX: Loofah sounds

>> RACHEL: Yeah neither have I.

>> PETER: *Getting louder.* No one appreciates me! Everyone treats me like I'm just a big joke. The "snack" guy. But I'm so much more than that, I know it!! Oooh what's this room? I've never seen it before and the door looks very official like I'm not supposed to enter. Gonna enter!

SFX: Door open
SFX: Bustling coffee shop

>> NEWS REPORTER: Everyone everywhere is buzzing with affection for newest rising star Peter Peter Popcorn Eater, whose popcorn catching tricks have taken the world by storm. His coffee shop performance last night has gone viral on the Internet-

>> NEWS REPORTER 2: Peter Peter Popcorn Eater's star continues to rise as he heads out on a world tour-

>> NEWS REPORTER 5: I'm here today with Peter Peter Popcorn Eater, the number one biggest celebrity in the world! Ok so, Peter, the Peter Cinematic Universe film franchise is the number one film franchise in history. Is there anything you'd like to say to your fans out there?

Peter is now a major diva.

>> PETER: Sorry, I'm busy. Please, no photos.

SFX: Papparazzi flashes

>> SIMON: Hey, hey, he said no photos. Back, you vultures! Back! Peter Peter Popcorn Eater has a big show tonight! He needs room to prepare! You're gonna get him out of his zone!

MUSIC: Gliss



>> SIMON: Well, Peter, it's the night of the big show. What do you say we get out there and knock their socks off? What do you say? What do you say? >> PETER: I'm not finished getting ready! >> SIMON: No, of course not, I would never rush you. You're my big star! >> PETER: Assistant! Fetch me my lemon water. >> SIMON: Assistant! Lemon water! >> ASSISTANT: Of course Mr. Popcorn Eater. >> PETER: Now hold it for me while I sip. >> ASSISTANT: Of course. Peter slurps. >> PETER: I'm sweating! >> MEGHAN: Peter it's us!

>> PETER: Who is "us?"

>> LEE: Meghan and Lee and Rachel and Nimene!

>> ALL: Hey Peter!

>> PETER: Well, well, well. If this isn't like staring at the past.

>> SIMON: Alright, no autographs before the show, Peter, shall I rid you of these groundlings?

>> PETER: No no, let them speak their peace. Why have you come?

>> MEGHAN: We miss you!

>> NIMENE: The Title Wave hasn't been the same since you left.

>> LEE: We wanted to ask you come back.

>> PETER: Come back? After all I've seen and done? You never appreciated me then and now you just want to hitch a ride on my shooting star.

>> MEGHAN: Peter, we always thought you were a star! But that's not why we miss you. We miss you because you're our friend.

>> PETER: Too little too...late. My manager will show you the door.

>> SIMON: THAT'S the door.

>> Lee: Ummm... that's a window.



>> NEWS REPORTER 2: Peter Peter Popcorn Eater's third studio album, Peter Peter Popcorn Singer has been panned by every single critic in the world.

>> NEWS REPORTER 1: Is Peter Peter Popcorn Eater a Peter Peter Popcorn Cheater. News

reports are claiming the plot of his new movie Popcorn Fast & Furious is stolen!



- >> NEWS REPORTER 3: Today on the show, world popcorn markets continue to fall today. Will increased tariffs on caramel popcorn mean we all have to eat that gross cheese popcorn put in the holiday popcorn tins?
- >> NEWS REPORTER 4: Peter Peter Popcorn Eater, he was once the biggest star in the world, but where is he now? No one knows.

Music cuts out. SFX: Heartbeat monitor Peter is old now

- >> PETER: What has become of my life. I hardly recognize myself. Where *am* I now? You. You did this to me.
- >> SIMON: Me? I did what I promised. I made you a star!
- >> PETER: But stars fall. Stars fall!! And now what do I have?
- >> SIMON: Uh, I dont know, how about millions and millions of dollars?
- >> PETER: Money yes. But respect? Friendship?
- >> SIMON: I'm your friend, Peter!
- >> PETER: You only care about how much money I can make you!
- >> SIMON: That's not true! Is someone paying you to say that? And how much are they paying you to say that? What's ten percent of that?
- >> PETER: I gave up everything for fame and glory and now I have nothing. I should have never walked into your talent competition!
- >> SIMON: Hey, I MADE you, kid!
- >> PETER: Simon, I can't do this anymore. You're fired.



>> SIMON: Fired? You can't fire me! You're nothing without me! You'll regret this, kid! They always do! Where is the door? I'd like to slam it dramatically, but I don't have my glasses. Door? No, that's the fridge. Gosh, it looks so much like a door. Okay, here we go. So long, Peter Peter Popcorn TRAITOR!

SFX: Door slam

>> SIMON: (muffled through door) Was that the door? YES! That was the DOOR! Hello? Coffee shop? Talent competition night is BACK ON!

>> PETER: Oh what I wouldn't give to spend another moment aboard the Title Wave with my dear friends Meghan, Lee, Rachel and Nimene.

>> MEGHAN: Peter?

>> PETER: I can almost hear them now. Saying my name.

>> LEE: Peter?

>> PETER: Can you hear it? It almost too real.

>> RACHEL: Peter!

>> PETER: But it's not real. None of it is real!

Peter starts sobbing

>> RACHEL: Thats it, I'm turning this thing off.

SFX: Machine powering down.

>> RACHEL: Peter are you ok?

>> PETER: What have I done?!?!



>> RACHEL: Peter! Hey, Peter! Open your eyes!

>> PETER: Wha? Where am I? Where's my mansion? My millions? My manager? My maid? My Mamma Mia memorabilia? My-

>> RACHEL: Peter, you were inside a simulation!

>> PETER: Huh?

>> ALL: Yeah huh?

>> RACHEL: I built a SimulRoom on the ship so we can do training exercises and, you know, take vacations without taking vacations.

>> PETER: So none of that was real?

>> RACHEL: No!

>> PETER: I didn't catch popcorn in my mouth for 20,000 people at Madison Square Garden?

>> ALL: No!

>> PETER: Oh I'm so happy! I'm sorry I was mad at you guys and then I came in here and I lived a whole lifetime and well... I was wrong to ever think that I didn't need you guys.

>> LEE: Aw, thanks Peter! Come on, let's go watch a movie or something! I made popcorn.

>> PETER: Shudders. I think I'll skip the popcorn. Can we do another story though?

>> ALL: Yeah!

>> LEE: Okay listeners, this next story is about a contest! And in this contest you have to s-p-e-I-I. Here's the author to introduce it!



>> Nyla: Hi! I'm Nyla, I'm nine years old and I'm from California. This is my story, "Spelling Snakesss".

Car pulling to a parking space. Bright and ambitious music. 80's synth and horns.

- >> PIPER: We finally made it to the park! Mom, could you have driven any slower?
- >> JAZZEY: I was just being careful! It's not every day that my daughter, Piper the Boa Constrictor is a contestant in the World Famous Spelling Bee!
- >> CORNY: Actually Mrs. Constrictor...
- >> JAZZEY: Corny, please. You're my daughter's best friend. You can call me Jazzey!
- >> PIPER: Can I call you Jazzey?
- >> JAZZEY: Not until you're in college.
- >> PIPER: Whatever.
- >> CORNY: So ACTUALLY Jazzey, Piper and I aren't entering a Spelling Bee.
- >> PIPER: Yeah mom, everyone knows that Bees can't spell.
- >> JAZZEY: That's why those bees at work can't do the crossword.
- >> CORNY: We're entering the world famous Spelling Sssnakes!
- >> PIPER: The world's premier spelling competition! As a snake, it's always been my dream to win it, and this is the year I'm going to do it!
- >> JAZZEY: Well you've been coiled up in your room, studying non-stop, so I think you're a shoo-in to win!



MUSIC: Curious/inquisitive

>> JAZZEY: Piper? >> PIPER: (muttering to herself) >> JAZZEY: PIPER CAN YOU HEAR ME?! >> PIPER: Ah! Sorry, I was deep in thought thinking of each word I know and how to spell them. Anyway, we should get going. The big tent where the competition is right over there. >> JAZZEY: Well good luck, Piper! Corny, you're competing too right? >> CORNY: Technically, yes. But I'm pulling for Piper all the way! >> PIPER AND CORNY: (in unison) Bye Mom/Jazzey. As Piper and Corny go towards the tent, we hear slithering/rattling sounds. >> PIPER: Woah, look at how large the tent is! I can't see an entrance anywhere. >> FAIRLY HANDSOME PORCUPINE: Excuse me, are you looking for the entrance to the Spelling Sssnakes? >> PIPER: Yes! Wait, who are you? >> FHP: Who me? Why I'm..... MUSIC: saxophone flourish. >> FHP: A fairly handsome porcupine!

>> CORNY: Coooool.



>> PIPER: Hi! Do you know where the entrance to the tent is? I'm competing this year, and I really don't want to miss the competition!

>> FHP: Then slither along and follow me! All of the other contestants are on stage, and it's about to start!

>> PIPER: Ah! Well let's go!

>> FHP: The entrance is just beyond this curtain.

Slithering/rattling as they make their way into the tent. As they enter the tent, the sound of an audience swells.

>> CORNY: Woah, this place is massive! They've got over 100 spotlights for the stage alone!

>> PIPER: Look at those bleachers! They must fit over 10,000 people!

>> FHP: And don't forget the most impressive part: the million light laser show!

Laser sounds

>> PIPER AND CORNY: WOAHHHHHH!

>> FHP: Well, we've made it just in time! You should be able to find your specific podium on stage. Good luck!

>> PIPER: Thank you, Handsome Porcupine!

>> FHP: Please, I'm FAIRLY handsome. Goodbye!

Same "Baker Street" sax sting

>> PIPER: Let's get on stage!



>> PIPER: There are so many other contestants here! BAH! I'M FREAKING OUT!

>> CORNY: Hey! Whenever you get nervous, just look over at me for our secret signal. Remember, tongue out...

>> PIPER & CORNY: Hissing

>> CORNY: Wink.....

Tinkerbell bell

>> PIPER and CORNY: And don't forget to smile!

>> PIPER: Thanks Corny! Oh, it's about to start!

Audience grows quiet. People being shushed

MUSIC: Similar to "Roundball Rock"

>> ANNOUNCER: Ladies and Gentleman, welcome to the 16th annual Spelling Sssnakes! Now please welcome your host, the most fabulous, incredible, and socially well respected host in the world: Gabby the Gerbil!

>> ALL: Audience erupts in applause

>> ALL: "We love you Gabby!" etc.

>> GABBY: Oh, for me? Thank you, thank you! No, YOU'RE the world's greatest host haha. No, it's actually me. We know that?hhh What an introduction! Welcome everyone, to Spelling Sssnakes. Today, we'll be figuring out which contestant is the best speller in the entire world! Before we start, let's meet our contestants. First up, Richard the Walrus!

>> RICHARD: Arf, arf. Hello!



>> GABBY: Melanie, the Praying Mantis. >> MELANIE: Yes yes yes, thank you! >> GABBY: Corny the Rattlesnake! >> CORNY: Hello, hello! >> GABBY: And finally, Peeper the Boa Constrictor! >> ALL: Audience laughs >> PIPER: Oh no! She got my name wrong! This is so embarrassing! >> GABBY: Ah! Sorry, that's PIPER the Boa Constrictor. >> ALL: It's okay Gabby / We love you Gabby! / etc. >> GABBY: Oh stop!
